

Vienna Mayor and Council met April 12 at 7 p.m. at City Hall. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Emerson Lundy with Beth English, Eddie Daniels, Brenda Gramm and Walter Brown present.

Brenda Gramm gave invocation, then everyone stood to recite the pledge of allegiance.

English made motion to amend agenda to add item 8 a. Proclamation for Fort Valley Head Start, and to change item 11 to Property Tax Collections. Gramm seconded and all agreed to accept amended agenda.

Brown made motion to accept previous minutes as presented, Gramm seconded and all agreed.

Gramm made motion to accept second reading to rezone 302 N 3rd St from R-1 to C-1, Daniels seconded and all voted to accept.

Daniels made motion to accept Georgia Cities Week Resolution, Brown seconded and all agreed to this resolution.

English made motion to approve amendment for Task Order #2 and Task Order #3 from CH2M Hill contingent upon approval of city attorney. Gramm seconded and amendments were unanimously approved contingent upon approval of attorney.

Gramm made motion to table accepting Excavation and Trenching Program policy until city attorney Verlin Jones has chance to look over. Brown seconded motion and all agreed to table decision.

Daniels made motion to accept City Clerk, Gail Bemby's recommendation to name city's gas consultant, Harpe and Associates as Municipal Gas Authority voting delegates for the City of Vienna. Gramm seconded and all agreed.

English made motion to accept Fort Valley Head Start Proclamation, Daniels seconded and this proclamation was unanimously accepted.

Bembry made recommendation to accept bid of \$1350.00 per cutting from R&M Lawn Service for cutting city cemetery. Mayor Lundy informed council that Ricky Crozier of R & M Lawn had stated that he underbid and that he may not be able to cut for this amount. English made motion to rebid, Gramm seconded and all agreed to rebid if R&M could not accept for \$1350 per cutting.

No one from DCUTS came before council.

English made motion to began process of collecting delinquent property taxes. Gramm seconded and all agreed to taking necessary action to collect delinquent taxes.

Janet Joiner, Community Development Director, gave Community Development Report. English made motion to reject recommendation to sell area of land beside old Red Cap Bldg. Daniels seconded and it was unanimously agreed that this land would not be sold at this time.

Council looked over report presented by Police Department.

Bembry gave City Clerk's Report. English gave Legislative Report.

Gramm stated that all citizens should take part in keeping city clean. Brown stated concerns of pot holes in some streets. Daniels was also concerned about pot holes on Old Cordele Road and Coney Road. He also stated that he was proud to see junk cars being moved from several properties within the city. Daniels also committed on street light being out on West Pine Street. Daniels asked to have a report from Police Department on number of tickets issued on sagging pants and inappropriate dress. English asked about leak detection on water and sewer system. Mayor asked about progress on 7th Street light and advised that city would check on cost of shredder to help with disposing of limbs and yard debris.

With no other business to come before council meeting was adjourned.
