

City of Vienna Mayor and City Council met April 26, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. at Vienna City Hall. Members present included Mayor Emerson Lundy and Council members Beth English, Eddie Daniels and Walter Brown. Lundy called meeting to order, Brown lead prayer and everyone joined in the Pledge of Allegiance. Daniels made motion to accept agenda as presented, English seconded and all agreed. Brown moved to approve previous minutes, English seconded and with all agreeing the previous minutes were approved.

Stephanie Langley, Vienna Better Hometown, advised members that Youchiria Ridley was the "If I Were Mayor" contest winner in Vienna and that her essay had been sent to GMA to compete at state level. She also advised that City of Vienna normally gives prize to local winner, but Ridley has moved and Langley has not been able to locate her.

English made motion to approve proclamation to name May Historic Preservation Month. Brown seconded and all agreed.

Janet Joiner, Vienna Community Development Director, stated that only one bid had been received for Hwy 215 Landscaping Project and that this bid was from McGraw Landscaping and that bid is within recommendations. English made motion to award bid to McGraw Landscaping, Brown seconded and bid was unanimously accepted.

After discussion with Susan Arnett of DCUTS, English made motion to approve DOT Grant Application for DCUTS operation for 2010-2011 year with stipulation that grant could be revised if city isn't able to allocate funds to DCUTS when budget is set for 2010-2011 year. With no second the motion died.

Kenny Calhoun, EMA Director Dooly County, came before council asking members to sign Emergency Management Ordinance. Attorney Verlin Jones recommended that wording in ordinance be changed so that county chairman would not be over city officials in an emergency within the city. Acceptance of ordinance was tabled until wording could be changed.

City Clerk, Gail Bembry, recommended amending budget to include some changes within departments, with no overall change to total budget. Daniels made motion to amend 2009-2010 budget to include recommended changes, English seconded and budget was unanimously amended.

Public works Director, Nathan Jordan, gave his report during the 6 p.m. workshop due to not being able to attend regular meeting.

Langley, introduced Recycling Chairperson Kathryn Braxton, and advised council that she is checking on prices of chipper.

Daniels asked if report had been received on number of citations for sagging/indecnt pants that had been issued. Clerk advised that no citations had been written at this time. Council discussed rewording ordinance so that more restrictions on this could be enforced.

With no other business to come before council, meeting was adjourned.
