

Mayor Emerson Lundy called Vienna City Council Meeting to order at 7 p.m. Monday March 22, 2010 with Mayor Lundy, Eddie Daniels, Beth English and Brenda Gramm present. Invocation was presented by Daniels and all stood for the pledge of allegiance.

Daniels made motion to accept agenda as presented, Gramm seconded and all agreed. Brown moved to approve previous minutes, English seconded and with all voting yes the minutes were approved.

Mr. Tavoris Brown came before council with application for beer and wine permit for his establishment, Adams Lounge, at 815 Mitchell Street. Ms. Gail Bembry, City Administrator, advised that Brown had all papers in order and that a criminal background check had been run. After questions to Brown about hours of operation English made motion to approve application, Daniels seconded and application was unanimously approved.

English made motion to table decision on DCUTS Resolution until next meeting when a representative from that entity could be present to answer several questions and concerns. Gramm seconded and all voted to table decision until April 12<sup>th</sup> meeting.

City Clerk, Gail Bembry gave report to council. She advised of necessary pump repairs that had not been budget items. She also suggested that council meet on April 12 at 6 p.m. for a budget workshop. Bembry advised that she had talked to county about their being contracted to hold city elections. Daniels stated that he would not be in favor of such contract unless there was large savings. Bembry also mentioned that public works has need for new vehicle. English asked that she obtain information and bring to budget discussion on April 12<sup>th</sup>.

English discussed several legislative alerts and reminded everyone to stay in touch with their representatives.

Gramm made motion to go into executive session to discuss personnel, possible litigation and/or land acquisition. Brown seconded and with all agreeing executive session began.

Gramm made motion to end executive session and resume regular session. Daniels seconded and all agreed to resume regular session.

English expressed concerns with garbage in city not being picked up in timely manner. Daniels asked that public works employees cleanup equipment. Brown asked about Water Park. Brown also, had concerns of pot holes in streets. Gramm too, had concerns about garbage pile up in city.

With no other business to come before council meeting was adjourned.
